Contributions to Contributions to Friends of Carolyn4Senate are not tax-deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. The maximum amount an individual may contribute is \$3,300 per election, \$9,900 total per election cycle. Your contribution will be first designated up to \$3,300 for the convention election. Federal law requires us to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of the employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year. Contributions from corporations, labor unions, federal contractors, and foreign nationals are prohibited. An individual may write one check for \$9,900. A couple may write a check for up to \$19,800 from a joint account (where both names are listed on the account) if this form is completed and signed by both contributors.
